We recommend for overseas participants to spend an overnight in Port-Moresby before departing to Lae, as international flights might be delayed therefore not allowing time for catching the domestic flight to Lae.

## Citizens from the following countries can get a visa on arrival:

Solomon Islands, Vanuatu, Fiji, American Samoa, Federated States of Micronesia (FSM), Kiribati, Marshall Islands, Nauru, Palau, Samoa, Tonga, Tuvalu and the French Territories of French Polynesia (Tahiti), Wallis and Futuna and New Zealand passport holding countries and territories including Cook Islands, Niue, Tokelau and the United States territories of Guam and Northern Mariana Islands.
